- f. The store must be suitable for use in tropical climate. Certificate should be provided to this effect by the manufacturer along with the offer and stores.
- g. The year of manufacture of the store should be current year i.e contracted calendar year. Certificate should be provided to this effect by the manufacturer along with the offer and stores.
- h. All marking and other details should be in distinct English language.
- j. All certificates and letter of authorization should be original and in English language.
- k. The store should be safe in storage, transportation etc and should not cause any health hazard. Certificate should be provided to this effect by the manufacturer along with the offer and stores.
- l. Guarantee Certificate for supply of store as per offer to be provided by the manufacturer along with the offer and stores.

**2. Warranty and Shelf Life Certificate by the manufacturer as mentioned below should be furnished along with the offer and stores.**

(1) **Warranty Certificate.** The store supplied is brand new, free from impurities and that in the event of any shortage, defect/damages being found after inspection the store should be replaced by the supplier at their own cost within 06 (six) months of the case arises. The warranty period of the store will be 12 (twelve) months from the date of issue of "Inspection Note" by IA&E.

(2) **Shelf Life Certificate.** The shelf life of the stores will be minimum 03 (three) years under normal storage condition and will be suitable for tropical climate. If the store is found defective within the shelf life of the stores must be replaced by the supplier at their own cost (CFR basis) within 06 (six) months as the case arises.

**3. Packing :**

- a. The packing of goods should be moisture proof, suitable for easy handling, storage transportation. Also, it should be packed as per internationally accepted packing boxes/bags.
- b. The stores are to be securely packed with sea worthy packing and clearly marked safe transit by Air/Sea. The box/package should have suitable means for holding by hands. should be easy to handle for storage and transportation.
- c. Packing material to be such that it will not be affected by damp, insect or any other harmful material during storage up to the shelf life of the store i.e 05(five) years shelf life. manufacturer should give a certificate to this effect while submitting offer and stores.

4. **Marking on the Packing Box.**

- a. Following marking to be stenciled on the top of the box/package :
- (1). Consignee : Commandant, Bangladesh Ordnance Factories, Gazipur Cantonment, Bangladesh.
  - (2) Contract number & dt: .....
- b. Following marking to be stenciled on the front side of the box/package :
- (1) Number of stores package.
  - (2) Full nomenclature of the stores.
  - (3) Lot number, year of manufacture, and factory code.
  - (4) Dimension of the box/package.
  - (5) Net weight of the box/package.
  - (6) Gross weight of the box/package.
- c. Following marking should be stenciled on the right or left side of the boxes:
- (1) Package number.
  - (2) Year of manufacture.
  - (3) Factory code.
  - (4) UN number.
- d. Manufacturer and quality certificate should be attached with the box/package with information:
- (1) Manufacturer or its symbol.
  - (2) Result of chemical test.
  - (3) Lot number.
  - (4) Code no of specification.
  - (5) Date of testing.

5. **Post Shipment Inspection:** The stores on being received at the consignee's end will be inspected by Inspectorate of Armaments & Explosive (IA&E). The inspection team will carry out visual inspection of the stores, chemical, functional and firing test. IA&E will issue final inspection report after the completion of visual inspection, chemical, functional and firing test.

6. **Inspection Certificate.** Final Inspection Certificate from the manufacturer should be provided along with the store by the supplier and should be mentioned in the tender.

7. **Part Shipment :** Part-Shipment is not allowed.

8. **Trans Shipment :** Trans-Shipment is not allowed.

9. **Authority Holding Sealed Particulars :** IA&E, Gazipur Cantt.

10. **Inspection Authority :** Chief Inspector, IA&E or his authorized representative.

11. **Country of Origin :** Group A country.
